Providing Quality Care and Services for Older Adults

In an average year, Renville Health Services cares for approximately 145 residents and tenants. Often the percentage of residents from Renville and the surrounding communities is greater than 90%.

Renville Health Services awards scholarship monies to assist staff in furthering their education. In 2015, over \$12,000 in scholarships were given for those obtaining Licensed Practical Nursing and Registered Nursing degrees and Dietary Manager Certification.
